

City of Janesville Golf Courses COVID-19 Update – Effective 8-1-20:

We are excited to be open and provide an outlet for recreation and activity for the residents of Janesville and our guests. Our team is closely monitoring the impact of COVID-19 and taking preventative measures to ensure that we are providing the highest level of service and cleanliness to our guests. This situation remains fluid and may change at any time.

We are following the guidelines established by the Rock County Department of Health and the CDC for preventing the spread of the virus, and as such we have implemented additional measures at our facility to mitigate risk and reduce the spread of germs. This includes the following procedures:

1. The Clubhouse – **Masks are required while inside the clubhouse beginning August 1st.**
 - a. The Golf Shop is open, with social distancing and point of contact measures in place.
 - b. Our Café is open with indoor dining available at 50% capacity.
 - c. Patio seating is open and available, with 50% capacity.
 - d. Masks may be removed while eating or drinking and should be replaced when you leave the table.
 - e. All dining tables and chairs are cleaned thoroughly between uses.
 - f. Restrooms are open, with social distancing measures in place.
 - g. Card payments are recommended, cash payments are accepted.
 - h. We have installed plexiglass shields at all points of sale for an additional layer of protection for staff and our guests.

2. The Golf Course and Range
 - a. The golf course is open for walking and riding.
 - b. Golf carts are two-riders per cart. Requests for single-rider carts are subject to availability.
 - c. Golf carts are issued on a first-come, first-served basis and may not be reserved ahead of your tee-time.
 - d. Golf carts are cleaned and thoroughly sanitized after each use.
 - e. On-course restrooms are open, and are sanitized regularly.
 - f. Rental clubs are available and will be thoroughly cleaned after each use.
 - g. Tee time intervals will be set at 10 minutes apart for social distancing.
 - h. No ball washers or bunker rakes will be placed on the course.
 - i. On the greens, foam inserts have been placed in the hole. This enables the ball to sit higher in the hole, making it easier to retrieve. Flagsticks must remain in the hole.
 - j. All golfers are reminded not to touch the flagsticks.
 - k. The practice green is open.
 - l. The driving range is open, and golf balls are cleaned and sanitized after each use.
 - m. Scorecards and pencils are no longer being placed on the golf carts before use. Please pick up a scorecard and pencil from the Golf Shop prior to your round.

The health and safety of our staff and guests is our highest priority. We will continue to work with health experts to ensure that our staff is informed and prepared to host you at Blackhawk and Riverside Golf Courses. However, as we have told our staff, if you are feeling sick or exhibiting any signs of illness, please stay home.
